On behalf of the Organizing Committe of the 13th International Philosophy Olympiad it is my pleasure to invite your country's representation to take part in 2005 philosophical contest for high school students. 2005 IPO will take place in Warsaw from May19 till May 23. It's institutional hosts will be Institute of Philosophy and Sociology of the Polish Academy of Sciences and the Polish Philosophical Society, which has just celebrated its 100th anniversary. "PHILOSOPHY AND A DIALOGUE BETWEEN CULTURES" will be the theme of the 13th IPO that will be used to organize our intellectual activity apart from the contest itself.

Also, please use application forms from the web to send us – by e-mail - details about your team. We know that in many cases national olympiads are going to be organized during the first months of 2005 so the names of the students may be known later. In such cases please send the declaration of participation before the end of February and the names of the students later, but as soon as they are available.

I would like to remind all members of the jury that before the end of February we all should send our proposals of the contest topics to prof. Bhuvan Chandel, vice-president of FISP.
